- Be in the process of completing your senior year in high school.
- Have participated in the Sweet Expectations workshop program, or other special workshop (i.e. A Cappella with Deke Sharon) sponsored by the Champlain Valley Chorus on at least one opportunity.
- Have a minimum high school GPA of 3.0 or a B average.
- Have plans to attend either a 2 or 4 year college.

Application and Award Process

- Application and one letter of recommendation must be received or postmarked by April 15.
- Scholarship winner will be notified by May 15.
- One \$250 award will be given annually.
- Checks will be available to be presented at the winning student's year end Scholastic Award ceremony.
